DECISION

Dispute Codes MNDL-S, MNDCL-S, FFL, MNRL-S

Introduction

This hearing was convened as a result of the Landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution, made on December 12, 2019 (the "Application"). The Landlord applied for the following relief, pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*"):

- a monetary order for damage or loss;
- a monetary order for damage or compensation;
- a monetary order for unpaid rent;
- an order granting recovery of the filing fee; and
- to retain the security deposit.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 1:30 PM (Pacific Time) on May 14, 2020. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participants called into the hearing during this time. Therefore, as neither party attended the hearing by 1:40 PM, I dismiss the claim with leave to reapply. This is not an extension of any statutory deadline.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
