DECISION

<u>Introduction</u>

In this dispute, the tenant had sought to cancel a One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause under section 47 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act"). The tenant applied for dispute resolution on January 31, 2020 and hearings were held on April 6, May 29, and June 19, 2020.

Preliminary Issue: Settlement of Dispute

The parties agreed to settle this matter, and the terms of the settlement are as follows:

- 1. the tenant will complete the BC Housing registration application form;
- 2. the tenant will willingly move out of rental when appropriate housing is made available;
- 3. the landlord will cancel the One Month Notice to End Tenancy notice to end tenancy issued on January 21, 2020; and,
- 4. the tenant will not pursue an application for dispute resolution in respect of this application.

Conclusion

I order the parties to comply with the terms of the settlement agreement set out above.

Finally, I thank the parties for their efforts and diligence in reaching this settlement.
