DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> ET, FF

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the landlord to be allowed to end the tenancy early an to obtain an order of possession and to recover the cost of the filing fee.

Both parties appeared. During the hearing the parties agreed to settle these matters, on the following conditions:

- 1) The parties agreed to mutual end the fixed term tenancy; and
- 2) The parties agreed that the tenancy will end by mutual agreement on September 15, 2020.

This settlement agreement was reached in accordance with section 63 of the Residential Tenancy Act.

Conclusion

As a result of the above settlement, the landlord is granted an order of possession should the tenant fail to comply with the settlement agreement. As this matter was settled by agreement, I decline to award the cost of the filing fee to the landlord.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
