DECISION

Introduction

This hearing was convened by way of conference call concerning an application made by the tenants seeking a monetary order for money owed or compensation for damage or loss under the *Act*, regulation or tenancy agreement and to recover the filing fee from the landlord for the cost of the application.

Both tenants and legal counsel for the landlord attended the hearing, during which legal counsel for the landlord indicated that he had full authority to settle this dispute. The parties agreed to settle this dispute in the following terms:

- 1. the tenants will have a monetary order as against the landlord in the amount of \$5,000.00 in full satisfaction of any and all claims between the parties respecting this tenancy;
- 2. the landlord will provide payment to the tenants at the address disclosed during the hearing.

The parties confirmed at the end of the hearing that this agreement was made on a voluntary basis and that the parties understood the nature of this full and final settlement.

Conclusion

For the reasons set out above, and by consent, I hereby grant a monetary order in favour of the tenants as against the landlord pursuant to Section 67 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* in the amount of \$5,000.00, in full satisfaction of any and all claims between the parties with respect to this tenancy.

This order is final and binding and may be enforced.
