DECISION

Dispute Codes OPL

This matter was scheduled for a conference call at 11:00 a.m. on this date. The landlord participated in the teleconference, the tenant did not. The landlord filed this application seeking an order of possession pursuant to a Two Month Notice to End Tenancy for Landlord's Use of Property pursuant to section 49 of the Act. At the outset of the hearing the landlord advised that she is the owner of the home and that she has a bed where she sleeps in the unit. The landlord advised that she shares a kitchen with the tenant.

Section 4 of the Act addresses the issue before me as follows:

What this Act does not apply to

4 This Act does not apply to

(c)living accommodation in which the tenant shares bathroom or kitchen facilities with the owner of that accommodation,

The landlord confirmed that she does share a kitchen with the tenant, accordingly; I am unable to hear this matter as I do not have the jurisdiction to do so under the Act.

Conclusion

I decline jurisdiction to hear this matter; accordingly, this application is dismissed in its entirety without leave to reapply.
