Introduction

On September 14, 2020, the Tenant made an Application for Dispute Resolution seeking to cancel a One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause (the "Notice") pursuant to Section 47 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*"), seeking more time to cancel the Notice pursuant to Section 66 of the *Act*, seeking a repair Order pursuant to Section 32 of the *Act*, and seeking to recover the filing fee pursuant to Section 72 of the *Act*.

On September 17, 2020, this matter was set down for a hearing on November 5, 2020 at 11:00 AM.

The Tenant attended the hearing at 11:11 AM and requested to withdraw her Application in full.

Preliminary and Procedural Matters

I find that the Tenant's request to withdraw the Application in full does not prejudice the Landlord. Therefore, the Tenant's request to withdraw the Application in full was granted. I note this Decision does not extend any applicable timelines under the *Act*.

Conclusion

The Tenant has withdrawn her Application in full. I have not made any findings of fact or law with respect to the Application.
