Introduction

This hearing was convened by way of conference call concerning an application made by the tenant seeking an order cancelling a notice to end the tenancy for cause.

The tenant and the landlord attended the hearing, and the tenant was assisted by an Advocate.

During the course of the hearing the parties agreed to settle this dispute, and the notice to end the tenancy is cancelled. The parties will negotiate further terms of the tenancy agreement by way of an Addendum.

The parties confirmed at the end of the hearing that this agreement was made on a voluntary basis and that the parties understood the nature of this full and final settlement of this matter.

Conclusion

For the reasons set out above, and by consent, the notice to end the tenancy given by the landlord is hereby cancelled and the tenancy continues.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
