<u>Introduction</u>

Dated: June 21, 2021

This hearing was scheduled to convene at 11:00 a.m. this date by way of conference call concerning an application made by the landlord seeking an Order of Possession for cause; a monetary order for unpaid rent or utilities; an order permitting the landlord to keep all or part of the pet damage deposit or security deposit; and to recover the filing fee from the tenant for the cost of the application.

No one for the tenant joined the call, however an agent for the landlord attended the hearing and withdrew the application.
