## **DECISION**

## <u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to section 49 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*") for cancellation of the landlord's 4 Month Notice to End Tenancy for Demolition, Renovation or Construction (the "4 Month Notice").

Both parties attended the hearing and were given a full opportunity to be heard, to present sworn testimony, to make submissions and to call witnesses.

At the outset of the hearing the parties said that the tenants have vacated the rental unit and this tenancy has ended. The tenants withdrew their application for dispute resolution accordingly.

## Conclusion

The application is withdrawn in its entirety without leave to reapply.
