A matter regarding GOODRICH REALTY and [tenant name sussed to protect privacy] <u>DECISION</u>

Dispute Codes CNL-MT

Introduction

This hearing was scheduled to convene at 11:00 a.m. this date by way of conference call concerning an application made by the tenant seeking more time than prescribed to dispute a notice to end the tenancy and for an order cancelling a notice to end the tenancy for landlord's use of property.

An agent for the landlord attended the hearing prepared to respond to the tenant's application, however the line remained open while the telephone system was monitored for in excess of 10 minutes and no one for the tenant joined the call. Therefore, I dismiss the tenant's application without leave to reapply.

The landlord's agent advised that the tenant vacated the rental unit at the end of July, 2021 and the landlord has possession. Therefore, I make no further orders.

Conclusion

For the reasons set out above, the tenant's application is hereby dismissed.
