DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MNDCL-S, MNRL-S, MNDL-S, FFL

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an application by the landlord under the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for the following:

- A monetary order for unpaid rent and for compensation for damage or loss under the Act, Residential Tenancy Regulation ("Regulation") or tenancy agreement pursuant to section 67 of the Act;
- Authorization to retain all or a portion of the tenant's security deposit in partial satisfaction of the monetary order requested pursuant to section 72 of the Act;
- Authorization to recover the filing fee for this application pursuant to section 72.

JP attended as agent for the landlord ("the landlord"). and had opportunity to provide affirmed testimony, present evidence and make submissions. The hearing process was explained.

The landlord stated they were not recording the hearing.

Preliminary Issue - Service upon Tenant

At the outset, the landlord explained they were unable to serve the tenant in compliance with the Act and the Rules.

Accordingly, the landlord withdrew the application with leave to reapply.

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Conclusion

The application is withdrawn with leave to reapply except for the application for reimbursement of the filing fee which is dismissed without leave to reapply.
