DECISION

Introduction

The tenants applied to dispute a Two Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause under section 47 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* ("Act"). In addition, they applied to recover the cost of the filing fee under section 72 of the Act. One of the tenants and a representative for the landlord attended the hearing on December 9, 2021.

Preliminary Issue: Settlement of Dispute

The tenant advised that they gave their ten-day notice to vacate on the evening of December 8, 2021, and that it is their intention to vacate the rental unit. I canvassed with the parties the option of resolving this dispute as a settlement; they agreed.

Pursuant to section 63 of the Act ("Opportunity to settle dispute"), then, the parties agreed to the following terms of settlement:

- 1. That the tenants shall vacate the rental unit no later than Sunday, December 19, 2021 at 1:00 PM (Pacific Standard Time); and,
- 2. That the landlord is granted an order of possession of the rental unit.

As the parties reached a resolution of this dispute through settlement there is no award of costs for the application filing fee.

This decision is made on delegated authority under section 9.1(1) of the Act.
