A matter regarding CAPREIT and [tenant name suppressed to protect privacy] **DECISION**

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened by way of conference call concerning an application made by the tenant seeking an order cancelling a notice to end the tenancy for cause.

The tenant attended the hearing accompanied by an agent and assisted by a Case Manager. An agent for the landlord also attended.

At the commencement of the hearing the parties agreed to settle this dispute, and the One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause dated November 10, 2021 is cancelled and the tenancy continues. The parties confirmed at the end of the hearing that this agreement was made on a voluntary basis and that the parties understood the nature of this full and final settlement of this matter.

Conclusion

For the reasons set out above, and by consent, the One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause dated November 10, 2021 is hereby cancelled and the tenancy continues.
