<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened by way of conference call concerning an application made by the landlord seeking an Order of Possession ending the tenancy earlier than a notice to end the tenancy for cause would take effect.

The landlord was represented at the hearing by an agent, however the line remained open while the telephone system was monitored for in excess of 10 minutes and no one for the tenant joined the call.

The landlord's agent advised that the tenant vacated the rental unit late last night, leaving the keys on the counter, and the landlord has possession. Therefore, I dismiss the landlord's application.

Conclusion

For the reasons set out above, the landlord's application is hereby dismissed.
