Introduction

This hearing was convened by way of conference call. The Landlord filed an Application for Dispute Resolution May 17, 2022 (the "Application"). The Landlord applied for an Order of Possession based on a One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause (the "Notice") and to recover the filing fee.

M.V. appeared at the hearing as an agent for the Landlord. The Tenant appeared at the hearing with R.M., their girlfriend.

M.V. advised at the outset of the hearing that the Landlord is no longer seeking an Order of Possession based on the Notice. M.V. withdrew the Application and the Tenant agreed to the withdrawal.

The Application is withdrawn by agreement of the parties.

The Application is withdrawn by agreement of the parties.
