<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenants to cancel a Two Month Notice to End Tenancy for Landlord's Use of Property, (the "Notice") and to recover the cost of the filing fee.

Only the landlord appeared. This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 11:00 A.M on this date. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and the only participant who called into the hearing during this time was the landlord.

As the tenants have vacated the rental, I find I no longer need to consider the merits of the Notice. Therefore, I dismiss the tenant's application without leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
