This hearing was convened to address the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution made on August 15, 2022. The Tenant applied for an order that the Landlord comply with the Residential Tenancy Act, the Residential Tenancy Regulation, and/or the tenancy agreement.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 9:30 A.M. (Pacific Time) on November 28, 2022. The Landlord was represented at the hearing by JB, an agent, who provided a solemn affirmation. JB testified that the tenancy ended on or about October 11, 2022. Although the telephone conference hearing remained open until 9:40 a.m., the Tenant did not attend.

Considering the above, I find that the Tenant's application is dismissed without leave to reapply.
