## **DECISION**

## <u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for:

- an order requiring the landlord to comply with the *Act*, regulation or tenancy agreement pursuant to section 62; and
- authorization to recover his filing fee for this application from the landlord pursuant to section 72.

This matter was scheduled for a conference call at 9:30 a.m. on this date. The tenant participated in the teleconference, the landlord did not. At the outset of the hearing the tenant advised that he had moved out in January 2023. As there is no longer an ongoing tenancy and the <u>only</u> issue applied for is in regards to an issue if there is an ongoing tenancy, this hearing is no longer required, accordingly; this application is dismissed in its entirety without leave to reapply.

## Conclusion

The tenant's application is dismissed in its entirety without leave to reapply.
