<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened as a result of the Applicant's Application for Dispute Resolution, made on February 3, 2023 (the "Application"). The Applicant applied for an order that the Landlord comply with the regulations, tenancy agreement or the *Act*, and for the return of the filing fee, pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*").

The Applicant, the Applicant's Advocate A.T., the Respondent's Agents E.K., J.C., and P.C. attended the hearing at the appointed date and time. At the start of the hearing, the parties confirmed that the living arrangement has come to an end. As such, I find that the Applicant's Application is moot. I therefore dismiss the Application without leave to reapply.
